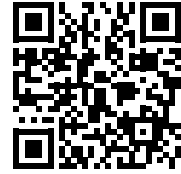

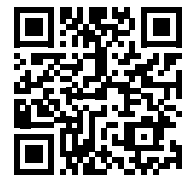

## For Organization Administrative Offices

- System for Award Management (SAM): required to do business with the federal government
- eRA Commons: required to do business with NIH
- Grants.gov: required to submit grant applications through the federal-wide grant portal
- Small Business Administration (SBA) Registration: required to participate in Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) programs
